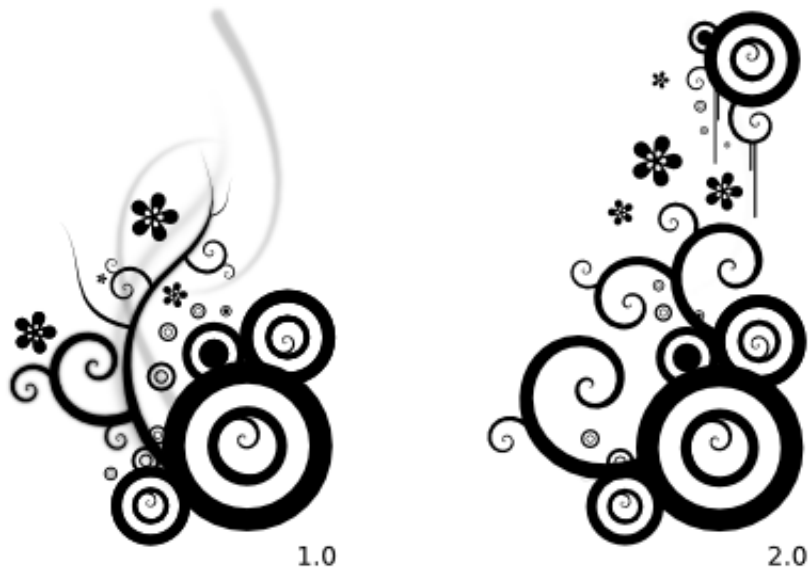


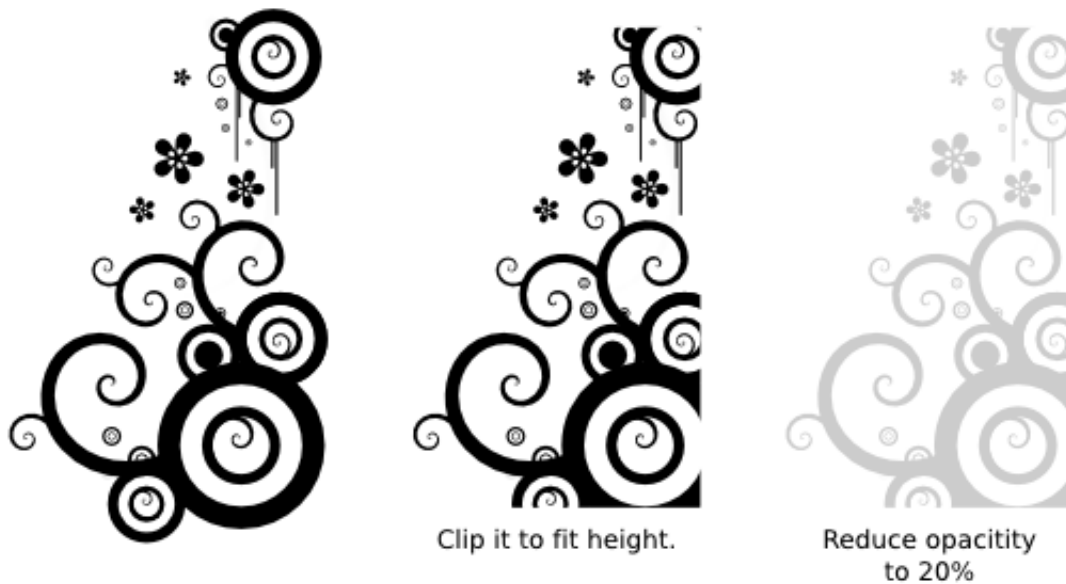
HowTo: Building TreeFlower's Artistic Motif

Step 1: Design the artistic motif



Step 2: Clip it and reduce opacity



Step 3: Set background design



Take the clipped artistic motif and set it over a plain blue color (#204c8dff) background.



Fog's pattern. Fog's pattern was created using GIMP's fog effect (Pythong-Fu > Effects > Add fog). Later it was imported to Inkscape and vectorized using the Tracing Bitmap tool. Finally its opacity was reduced to 50% and blurred to 1.1.



Align plain blue background and fog's pattern to perfectly match one over the other. At this point the object's layout (from bottom to top) is: 0 the plain blue background, 1 the artistic motif, 2 the object holding fog's pattern.

Step 4: Set left-to-right gradient



Gradient left color: #001d3cff
Gradient right color: #001d3c00
