

NAME

`allec` – force the most important ec-fonts to be calculated

SYNOPSIS

`allec` [`-r`]

DESCRIPTION

allec forces a large number of ec-style Fonts to be calculated as pixel files. This is done through running *dvips*(1) over a certain test-file. Therefore, the fonts are created in the resolution needed by *dvips*.

If the `-r` flag is specified, the command *dvired*(1) will be used instead of *dvips*.

alldc does not recalculate existing fonts (as long as the Metafont mode does not change).
